NIGHT WORK TO CONTINUE AT EXIT 3 IN WINDHAM NH

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces night work associated with the construction of the new northbound I-93 bridge over NH Route 111 in Windham, NH. Night work will begin on Tuesday, February 9th and should last until Thursday, February 11, weather permitting.

NH Route 111(Indian Rock Road) will be alternating one-way traffic with uniformed officers directing traffic. These periodic stoppages will take place during nighttime and early morning hours as follows:

Tuesday	2/09/2010	7:00 pm - 6:00 am
Wednesday	2/10/2010	7:00 pm - 6:00 am
Thursday	2/11/2010	7:00 pm - 6:00 am

This work is part of the construction of a new I-93 northbound roadway in the vicinity of Exit 3 on the new alignment. Middlesex Corporation of Littleton, Massachusetts is the general contractor for the \$25 million project, which is scheduled for completion in June 25, 2010.
