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LONGTERM TEMPORARY LANE SHIFT ON RTE 111
BETWEEN I93 SOUTHBOUND AND I93 NORTHBOUND

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces bridge work and Rte 111 traffic shift associated with the construction of the new Exit 3 interchange.

Beginning approximately Thursday, May 14th, traffic will be shifted to the south on Rte 111 in the vicinity of the future northbound bridge that is adjacent to the existing southbound overpass. The shift is necessary in order to allow for construction of the bridge pier footing. Minor traffic delays can be expected.

This work is part of the construction of a new I-93 southbound off ramp at Exit 3 on a new alignment. Middlesex Corporation of Littleton, Massachusetts is the general contractor for the \$25 million project, which is scheduled for completion in June 2010.

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
