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LANE CLOSURES ON I-93 NEAR EXIT 1 IN SALEM
BRIDGE DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION OF I-93 EXIT 1 RAMPS

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation announces lane closures on Interstate 93 at Exit 1 in Salem are scheduled to take place during the nights of Monday, June 22, through Friday, June 26. The lane closures will be on the I-93 northbound and southbound lanes between Exit 1 and Exit 2.

Weather dependent, lane closures for northbound traffic will be between 7:00 pm and 6:00 am each night. The lane closures for southbound traffic will be between 7:00 pm and 5:00 am each night.

Motorists using I-93 Northbound and Southbound near Exit 1 in Salem during these nighttime hours can expect minor traffic delays. There will also be traffic stoppages of short durations (five minutes or less) while the steel girders are removed from two old bridges over I-93.

Uniformed officers and traffic control devices will be used to assist motorists through the work zone.

This work is part of the \$22.3 million I-93 Exit 1 rebuilding project. The general contractor is SPS New England, Inc. of Salisbury, Massachusetts.

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
