EXIT 4 PARK-AND-RIDE/ BUS TERMINAL LONDONDERRY

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

Goguen Construction Company has completed construction of the new bus terminal at the Exit 4 Park-and-Ride (PNR) . Construction of the terminal began in January of 2006 and the terminal was opened to the public on May 14, 2007. There were minor improvements to the existing parking lot while the new facility provides improved access to bus services.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Improvements to the Exit 4 PNR are part of the Department of Transportation's overall plan to improve commuting options. Work has begun on the park-and-ride facilities at Exits 2 and 5, with future plans for a PNR at Exit 3. A bus terminal and bus maintenance facility will be constructed at Exit 5, and 275 new spaces for park-and-ride overflow will be created. A bus terminal similar to the one at Exit 4 will be constructed at Exit 2.

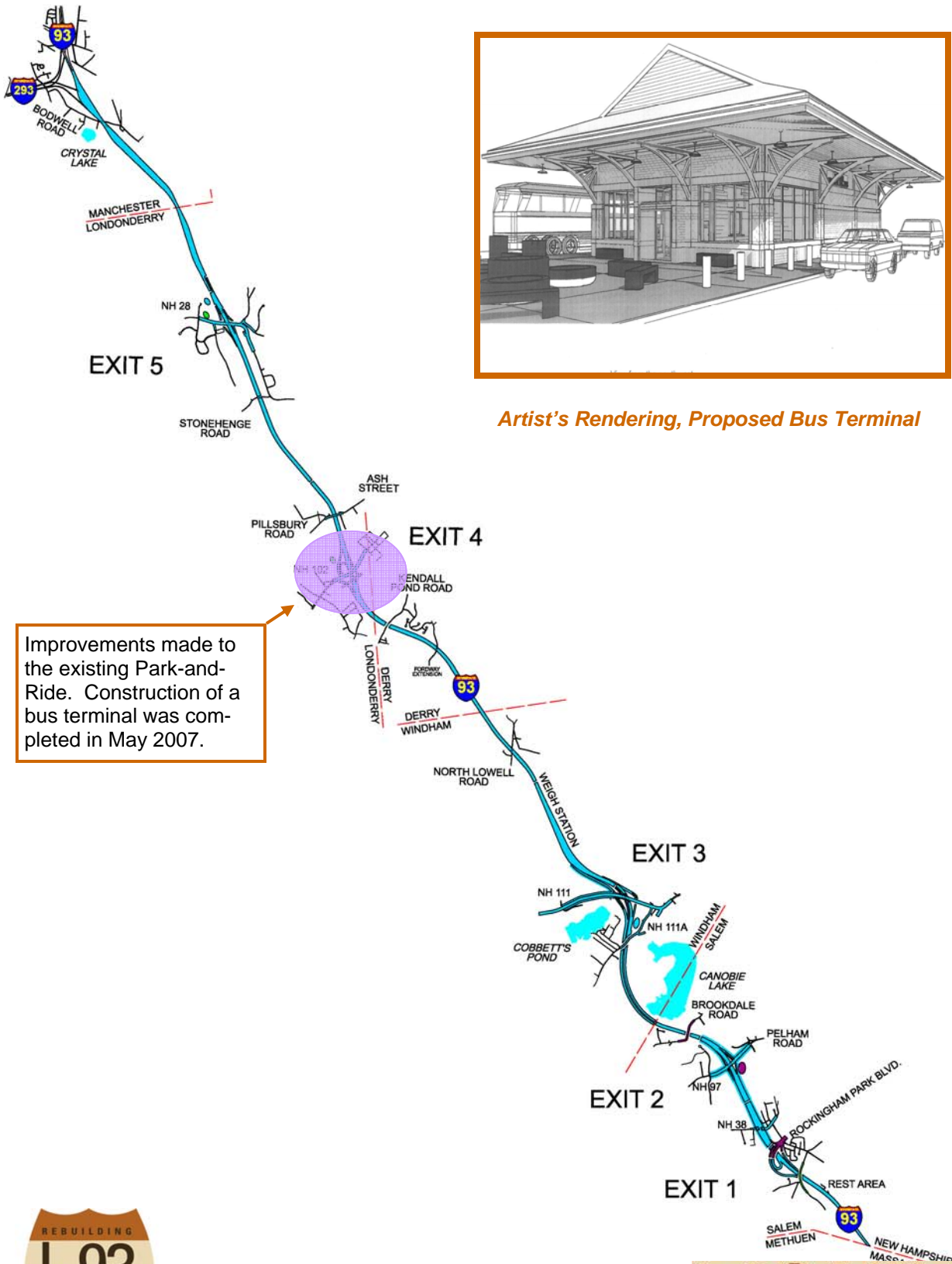
