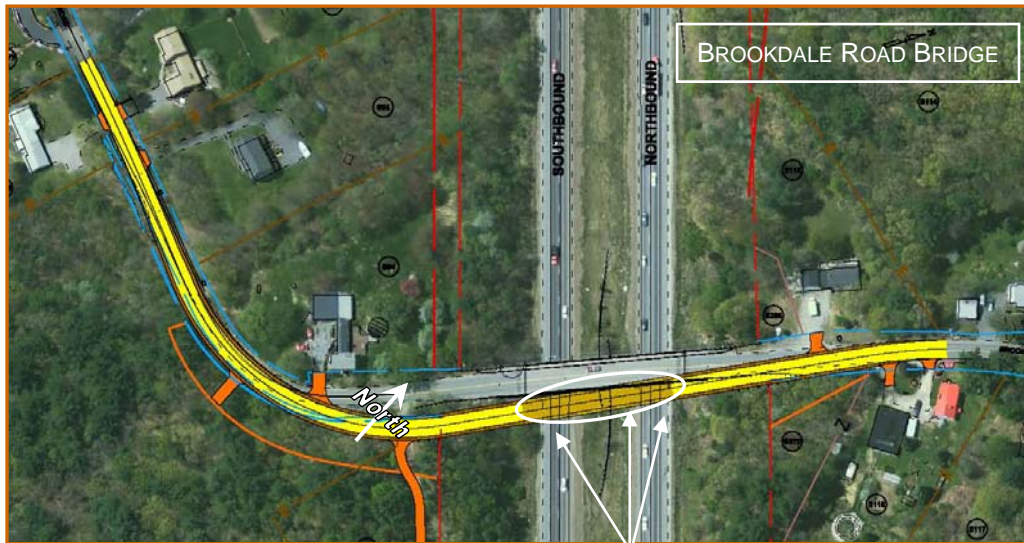


REBUILDING I-93 SALEM TO MANCHESTER



BROOKDALE ROAD BRIDGE ~ SALEM ~

PROJECT OVERVIEW: CONTRACT 13933F: This project has replaced the old bridge carrying Brookdale Road over I-93 just north of the Exit 2 interchange. That bridge was constructed in 1961 and was on the state's "red list" for deficient structures. The new 310-foot long, two span bridge is two lanes wide and will accommodate the future reconstruction of the interstate. Approximately 1,000 linear feet of Brookdale Road will also be reconstructed as part of this project. This project is substantially complete. Work is currently suspended pending completion of utility relocations, at which point the final paving work will be completed.
